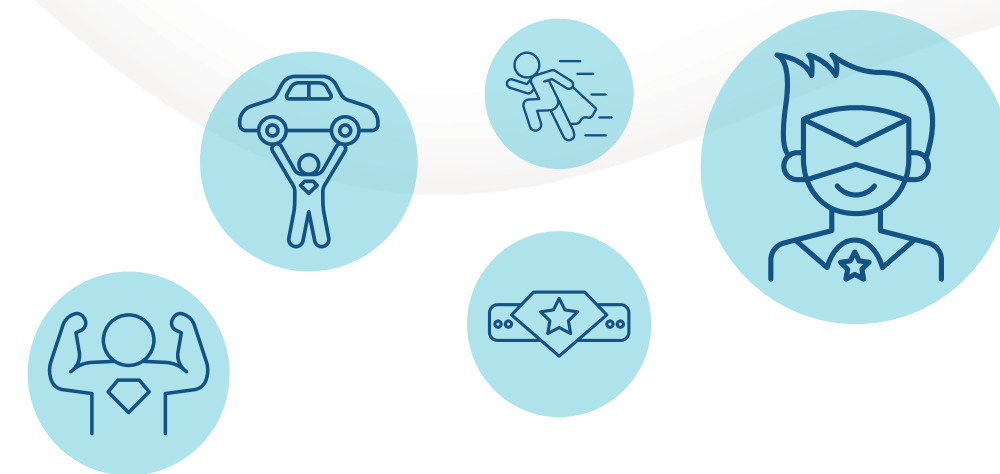

Your Speedy Recovery Powers:

Small Scars: The robot's arms are like tiny helpers that can go where regular tools might find it tricky. Because of this, the doctor will only make a few small cuts - and you may barely see the scars after you heal!

Back in Action: Because there are fewer and smaller cuts, you may be able to get up and move around soon after surgery.

Less Pain: The robot helps your doctor work using very tiny openings. That may mean you'll have less pain after surgery.



Is robotic surgery safe for kids?

Yes! The robot has safety features built in and is controlled by a specially trained doctor who knows exactly how to make you feel better.

Does the robot operate by itself?
